## INTRAVENOUS PYELOGRAPHY (ivP)

### Information on the X-ray

#### **Purpose of the examination**

The radiological examination is aimed at visualizing the kidneys and draining urinary tract, identifying renal calculi (kidney stones), diseases of the kidneys, both ureters and the urinary bladder. After draining the urinary bladder, the residual urine is assessed.

#### **Information on the examination**

Please make an appointment for this examination and bring the following with you to the examination:

- **E-card and photo ID**
- **Original assignment (it must still be valid)**
- **A current blood report (not older than 2 months), in which your kidney values (creatinine, GFR) and your TSH thyroid value were determined**

We do not perform X-ray examinations on pregnant patients in our practice!

In case of a known allergy to intravenously administered iodine-containing contrast agents, intravenous pyelography is not performed in our practice.

If you are under 14 years old, you must come to the examination accompanied by a parent or guardian or bring a written consent form.

#### **Preparing for the examination**

No special preparation is necessary for the examination.
