GASTRIC X-RAY & GASTROINTESTINAL PASSAGE

Information on the X-ray

Purpose of the examination

Your physician will refer you for a gastric X-ray to clarify a possible reflux disease, a hiatal hernia, ulcer diseases of the stomach and duodenum as well as other indications. The gastrointestinal passage should clarify whether the food passes the gastrointestinal tract in a timely manner.

Information on the examination

Please make an appointment for this examination and bring the following with you to the examination:

- **E-card and photo ID**
- **Original assignment (it must still be valid)**

We do not perform X-ray examinations on pregnant patients in our practice!

If you are under 14 years old, you must come to the examination accompanied by a parent or guardian or bring a written consent form.

Preparing for the examination

In order to achieve optimal examination results, please come to our practice on the day of the examination with an empty stomach (do not eat in the 6 hours before). You can take your daily medication as prescribed with a sip of water.
